Executive Summary

The Transport fare watch report for September 2018 covers the following categories namely bus journey within the city per drop constant route; bus journey intercity, state route, charge per person; air fare charge for specified routes single journey; journey by motorcycle (Okada) per drop; and water way passenger transport.


Average fare paid by commuters for bus journey within the city decreased by -0.66% month-on-month and increased by 42.25% year-on-year to N185.47 in September 2018 from N186.69 in August 2018. States with highest bus journey fare within city were Abuja FCT (N385.00), Cross River (N300.00) and Abia (N280.00) while States with lowest bus journey fare within city were Rivers (N125.00), Anambra (N100.90) and Bauchi (N110.00).


Average fare paid by commuters for bus journey intercity decreased by -0.03% month-on-month and increased by 19.32% year-on-year to N1,813.77 in September 2018 from N1,814.39 in August 2018. States with highest bus journey fare intercity were Abuja FCT (N4,500.00), Adamawa (N3,430.00) and Borno (N2,790.00) while States with lowest bus journey fare within city were Jigawa(N1,230.00), Anambra & Zamfara (N1,200.) and Bauchi & Enugu (N1,150.00).

Average fare paid by air passengers for specified routes single journey increased by 0.15% month-on-month and decreased by -0.02% year-on-year to N32,378.92 in September 2018 from N32,330.41 in August 2018. States with highest air fare were Lagos (N41,500.00), Edo (N39,950.00) and Abuja FCT (N39,800.00) while States with lowest air fare were Oyo (N23,500.00), Osun & Katsina (N25,000.00), and Kogi (N25,800.00).

Average fare paid by commuters for journey by motorcycle per drop decreased by -1.30% month-on-month and 18.98% year-on-year to N119.04 in September 2018 from N120.62 in August 2018. States with highest journey fare by motorcycle per drop were Ondo (N200.00), Imo (N190.00) and Enugu (N185.00) while states with lowest journey fare by motorcycle per drop were Adamawa (N68.00) Jigawa (N70.00) and Kebbi & Abuja (N75.00).

Average fare paid by passengers for water way passenger transport increased by 0.21% month-on-month and decreased by -1.52% year-on-year to N595.51 in September 2018 from N594.26 in August 2018. 


Average Transport Fare Across States -Journey by Motorcycle (Okada) Per Drop




Average Transport Fare Across States -Waterway Passenger Transport






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Abia State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Abuja FCT






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Adamawa State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Akwa Ibom State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Anambra State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Bauchi State








Average Transport Fare by Categories -Cross River State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Delta State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Ebonyi State








Average Transport Fare by Categories -Ekiti State








Average Transport Fare by Categories -Kano State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Katsina State








Average Transport Fare by Categories -Nasarawa State










Average Transport Fare by Categories -Ondo State








Average Transport Fare by Categories -Oyo State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Plateau State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Rivers State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Sokoto State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Taraba State






Average Transport Fare by Categories -Yobe State

Methodology

Field work is done solely by over 700 NBS Staff in all States of the federation supported by supervisors who are monitored by internal and external observers.

Fuel Prices are collected across all the 774 local governments across all States and the FCT from over 10,000 respondents and locations and reflect actual prices households state they actually bought those fuels together with the prices reportedly sold by the fuel suppliers.

The average of all these prices is then reported for each state and the average for the country is the average for the state.

NBS audit team subsequently conducts randomly selected verification of prices recorded.
